Your child is invited to join us on a trip to the Houses of Parliament in London on Friday, **6th February 2026**. This trip is exclusively for older members of our school council and will be a joint visit with pupils from ASM, with both schools travelling together.

There is no cost for your child to attend. The trip is funded by the Learning Academy Partnership and the Parliament Education Fund, who together are providing this incredible opportunity for our children.

Proposed plan for the day:

- **5:15 am** – Dunsford pupils will meet ASM pupils at Exeter Service Station (M5, Junction 30, Sandygate Roundabout, Exeter EX2 7HF). ASM pupils will depart their school by coach at 5:00 am and travel to the service station to collect the Dunsford group.
- A toilet will be available on board the coach, and we will make a scheduled stop en route to stretch our legs.

On arrival in London, we will:

- Enjoy a sightseeing tour of landmarks such as Buckingham Palace, The Mall, and the Thames.
- Ride the London Eye at 11:00 am, giving the children an amazing panoramic view of the capital.
